Welcome to the Faculty of Law and Management (FLM) and congratulations on obtaining a seat on one of our programmes.

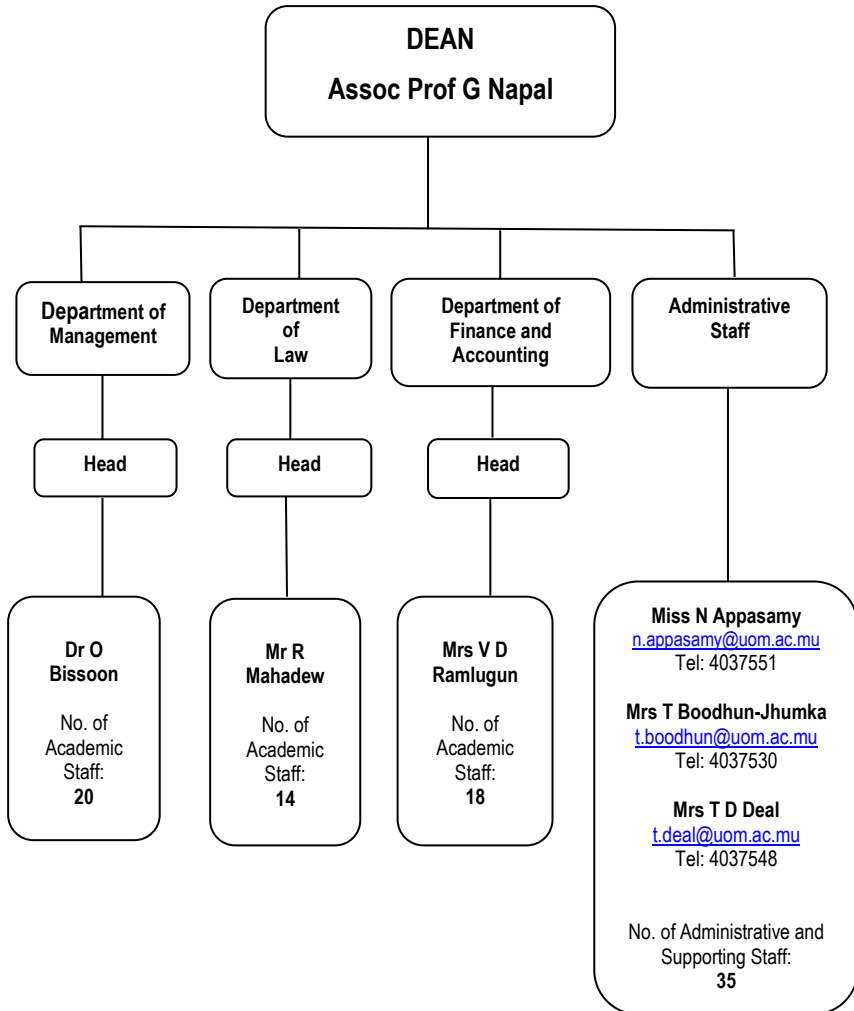
